### **Proposal for Blackout window treatments for The Denes.**

Our proposals for blinds and curtain at the above property, are to eliminate any light seepage to the outside.

Standard roller blinds with a blackout fabric, provide a good level of dimout to a room, however there will always be some light seepage due to the fabric being narrower than the window recess.

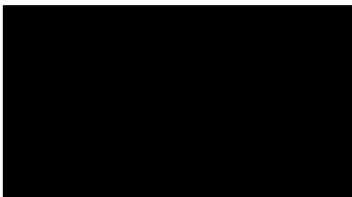
Blinds fitted outside the recess do reduce the light seepage, but do not eliminate it.

Our Blackout blind systems will provide 99.9% blackout; however, this is dependent on the colour of the hardware, and the choice of fabric.

As the blind is housed in an Aluminium box, and the fabric runs down inside 'Zip' side channels, this provides a near perfect blackout solution.

For the curtains, the tracks in the majority of rooms will be recessed into the ceiling. The curtains therefore virtually touching the ceiling, and finishing just off the floor, will provide A total blackout effect. Again, this is dependent of the choice of fabric.

Where a track, or pole is face fixed to a wall, there is always a chance that a small amount of light could leak over and behind the track, but with the track/pole being fitted as high as possible, this is very much reduced.
