Proposal: - T1- Fraxinus excelsior (Ash), Fell to ground level. Replant 1no. standard Quercus ilex in northern area of site.

Council staff have inspected the site to determine the appropriateness of the proposed works to the trees ongoing continuing amenity value.

Schedule of Conditions

1. The works should be carried out to the latest requirement of British Standard 3998 "Recommendations for Tree Work".

Reason: To safeguard the trees in the interest of visual amenity.

- The replacement tree must be planted on or near the existing tree by April 2025; the tree should be of a Qurcus ilex as proposed and of a size not less than 10-12cm girth when planted.
- 2 The tree work specified above must be carried out within 2 years of the date of this decision.

Reason: To ensure the work is only carried out once in respect of this consent and allow Ealing Council the opportunity to reconsider its decision in the light of prevailing circumstances, and reconsult on the case in the event of the consent expiring before implementation.

INFORMATIVES:

- 1 It is recommended that planting takes place between the months of October and March but being careful to avoid periods of waterlogging or hard frost.
- If the new tree's species is different from what has been suggested, then Ealing's Planning department must be consulted before planting is completed.
