


Reference Key – (scale 1:500)

- Existing Cornish Hedge
- Unmarked example pitches
- Existing Trees
- Proposed trees (see planting schedule)
- Proposed three metre buffer zone
- Proposed native species Hedging (see planting schedule)
- Access to PRoW from campsite through existing gate
- Access to campsite from public highway
- Existing gate ways



Planting schedule

Proposed new native double staggered hedge row of native species at 0.5m centres.

All shrubs to be planted as bare 90 - 60 cm root whips into existing ground. Plants will also be watered daily should periods of drought occur whilst establishing.

Percentage mix:

- 30% Hazel (Corylus avellana)
- 30% Hawthorn (Crataegus monogyna)
- 10% Elder (Sambucus nigra)
- 10% Blackthorn (Prunus spinosa)
- 5% Crab apple (Malus sylvestris)
- 5% Holly (Ilex aquifolium)
- 5% Dog rose (Rosa canina)
- 5% White willow (Salix alba)

Trees to enhance existing Cornish hedge:

- 5 English Oak trees (Quercus robur)
