T1 – Cedar Tree – growing in the front driveway of 61 and 6 Vanbrugh Park
A 1-2m all around reduction, to suitable growing points.
To remove the lower deadwood.
To trim back the branches growing towards the lamppost by 1m. To crown lift the branches that are growing over 60 Vanbrugh Park to give a 5m clearance.
To reduce the lower branches growing towards the house on the opposite side of the road.
To lift the lower branches growing over 63 Vanbrugh Park, to suitable growing points, to balance the tree. To clear all resulting debris from site.
