Condition 3 - Written Scheme of Investigation for Below Ground Works

Included within this application to discharge Condition 3 of Listed Building Consent application DC/23/03250, is the required Written Scheme of Investigation Report for archaeological monitoring and reporting at Wingfield College. This WSI was undertaken by Colchester Archaeological Trust in January of 2024 and has been produced following receipt of the Brief for Contiuous Monitoring and Recording at Wingfield College produced by Suffolk County Council Archaeological Service (SCCAS) in early January 2024. This brief will be included within the discharge of condition application to accopany the WSI.

It is hoped that excavation works (ie. Condition 4 - Implementation of Below Ground Works) can commence in March of 2024, subject to the discharge of Condition 3. It is intended that excavation works within the Kitchen, Great Hall and connecting Corridor would run simultaneously, rather than works within the separate areas taking place in stages. It would therefore be helpful to know your timescale for deciding this condition.

Once excavation works have been carried out, the intention is that proposed floor build-up details and and an application of discharge of Condition 5 would be submitted.
