Clean to remove all dead, diseased and broken branches $\frac{1}{4}$ centimetres in diameter and larger throughout crown

to improve health and appearance and reduce risk of branch failure.

· Thin crown to remove approximately 20% of live branches to reduce risk of branch stem and/or root failure.

Most thinning cuts will be between 0.25 and 1 centimetre in diameter.

· Remove all epicormic growth, reduce height by 0.5 meters by selectively removing taller branches in the upper crown when thinning.
