Thank you for consulting the Forestry Group on application 24/0157/TC - To cut back and reshape oak tree in the bottom right hand corner of our garden. Applied for in previous years when required.

This tree has been the subject of at least two previous s211 notification for works. The tree located to the rear of the property off Chapel Street and is not clearly visible to the public and as such the tree has limited merit as a public amenity. The proposed works to reshape or reduce the canopy of the tree has not been quantified in linear metres. It is important that works do not exceed that previously undertaken and maintain a healthy framework and appearance.

I therefore recommend that the Local Planning Authority Accept the notification and raise no objection.
