
Messenger Cottage, Tarlton

Application to do works to trees in a conservation area

T1: Copper Beech (purple dot); The application is to reduce the tree to near previous (Approximately by 25 % all over) and thin the internal structure (by up to 30%) accordingly in order to maintain its current size.



T2: Acer Griseum (the green dot); The application is to reduce the Acer to previous (approximately 30%). The owners like the shape of the tree, although it unfortunately sits below the unsheathed high voltage lines. The tree needs to be taken back to prevent interference with the lines in due course.



T3: Cherry (red dot): The application is to reduce the southern corner principally as it's grown to the light and the rest of the tree to balance (approx. 20%, although more on the southern side).
