I have been given instructions to plant 80 replacement trees over the Public realm locations at St James Park.

Would the following species be acceptable ?_

Acer campestre (upright clones)

Hornbeam both common and Fastigiata

Alders

Prunus Avium

Sycamore

Liquidamber

Acer Freemani / Rubrum types

Pyrus Chanticleer

Metasequoia

I am avoiding Birch, as many have already failed, as have Malus & Sorbus.

We will locate the replacement trees in the same position as the failed ones, but make sure suitable species are in the right location.

The planting team are a professional tree planting outfit (BALI members) and have planted trees for me for over 20 years.
