Recent storms have damaged the flashing, tiles and pointing at three locations on the roof of the building, allowing ingress of rainwater. If left unrepaired these will cause significant damage to the interior of the building. I have engaged a roofer and scaffolder to make repairs and impressed upon him the need to use materials comparable to the originals, in particular lead flashing and slate tiles. Scaffolding has been erected, but no work has yet commenced.
