


All the above locations are shown marked up on the original plan drawings 02 First floor 03 Second floor submitted as part of the planning application.

Repairs to the daub are to be done with original material saved on site. Any new mix to be clay and lime binder, earth & sand aggregate, horse & straw reinforcement. Plastering over will be using a chalk plaster to replicate original thin extremely hairy original plaster. Plaster finish will be smooth but uneven finish following the original daube surface — only one coat plaster to be applied — to match original.








Daub removed and reused to the partition wall panels.








Daub to be reuse/new daub to the window walls.
