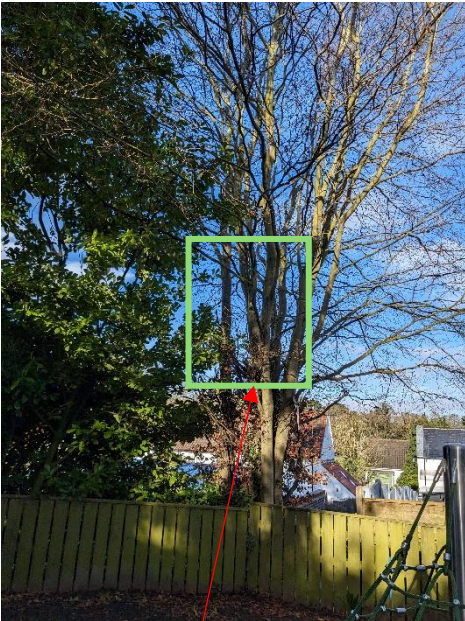

Bishop Burton Parish Council Proposed Tree works surrounding Bishop Burton Playground

Beech Tree A – Works proposed – to trim back five branches overhanging the playground as noted in green on the right hand photo below.

- 1) View of Beech Tree A from Playground 2) View of Beech Tree A from the back of the Playground.

Overhanging branches marked in green on photo above to be cut back to the main trunk

Beech Hedge

3) Current View along the fence/hedge



Application is to trim back overhanging branches to bring more light into the Playground and to reduce the amount of bird faeces on the equipment. Detail of the trimming proposed follows.

4) View towards Cold Harbour View

The three proposed branches to be cut back to the trunk on the left hand side are noted in



green. In the area with the blue oblong the green line denotes the branches that are to be cut back to where they meet the tree trunk to reduce the number of overhanging branches.

Cut back these three new branches to the main trunk

5) View towards Pudding Gate. Shows opposite end of beech hedge from 4)



6) On larger scale for clarity:



Laurel Hedge – propose to trim back to the fence.

7) View of laurel in context of playground



Note: no work to be carried out on Turkey Oaks or Scots Pine tree.
