# Identification of Tree(s) and Description of Works

The fig trees forming a hedge are at (1) on the plan 7PapillonsWalk sketch plan.pdf. We wish to cut back the branches that overhang 7 Papillons Walk along the boundary wall. Most of these are from the fig trees. They blight our garden when the leaves are out by taking our light and space and having a detrimental impact on the garden. These trees that overhang our garden have no amenity value, are not being properly managed by their owner (Bernersmede) and are in close proximity to other trees. Our previous written request to Bernersmede to prune tree brasnches which overhang our garden was completely ignored and there has been no change to the Board of Bernersmede Management Company since then.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
