



The proposed shed will be clad in vertical pine cladding boards that will be lightly charred to give a natural looking but dark finish to the wood. Charring the wood naturally protects the wood from wind, rain, rot and insects. A dark finish has been chosen for its ability to allow the structure to sit subtly in its surroundings.



An EPDM rubber membrane will be used on the roof. The flat, sloping roof will have a low profile meaning the rubber membrane will only be visible from above.



Anthracite grey, double glazed, aluminium bifold doors will be used.
