Operational Management Plan

Deliveries

Deliveries of milk are received twice weekly, in the early hours of the morning while delivering to other businesses. Local produce is delivered from Causeway Farm once weekly, in the early afternoon. Provisions from supermarkets are delivered once weekly in the early afternoon. All deliveries are received on Station Approach (Network rail property with public access 24/7) which is used by three neighbouring businesses, and members of the public both on foot and in vehicles.

The vehicles are arriving during quiet hours and as such have no need to implement silent reversing, however vehicles can use silent reversing if required.

Parking Arrangements

There are 16 parking spaces and 3 accessibility spaces available in the car park for use by the staff members throughout the day, as well as parents at pick-up and drop-off times for the children.

Management of External Areas

The external area is located to the front of the building, featuring a play area which is enclosed by a close-boarded fence. This prevents the children from leaving the area when let out for play, and prevents pedestrians gaining access to the site.
