

CHERITON FITZPAINE TOWER HILL, Cheriton Fitzpaine

7/46 Honeysuckle Cottage

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House. Probably late C17, extended in C19. Plastered cob on rubble footings; rubble stack topped with C19 brick; slate roof (formerly thatch). Original 2-room plan cottage facing west, with C19 extension on right (south) end. Large lateral stack is projecting to rear of right room of original house. C19 extension recessed from main block. 2 storeys. Symmetrical 2-window front to main block of late C19-early C20 casements with glazing bars and central 4-panel door. Interior of right room has large fireplace and a reused C16 chamfered and step-stopped cross beam which had a new piece of oak scarfed onto the front end and was pegged together and given a chamfered soffit with runout stops. Roof of A-frame trusses with pegged lap-jointed collars. Known as Smithwright Cottage until circa 1930.
