T1 Lime in Garden of 37 Sally Hill: Remove Epicormic growth, Crown lift and clean lower crown out by removing new growth from 2020 works and dead wood up to 5mtrs from base of crown.

Reason: to allow light to enter the garden from underneath the canopy and provide a clearance between the hedge line and the tree.

T2 Lime in Garden of 41 Sally Hill: Remove Epicormic growth, Crown lift and clean lower crown out by removing new growth from 2020 works and dead wood up to 5mtrs from base of crown.

Remove x1 crossing limber in lower part of crown over garden of 41 Sally Hill

Reason: to allow light to enter the garden from underneath the canopy and provide a clearance between the hedge line and the tree. Crossing Limbs can fail due to rubbing against each other.

These works were last carried out in April 2020 The tree shows no sign of decline due to the works.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
