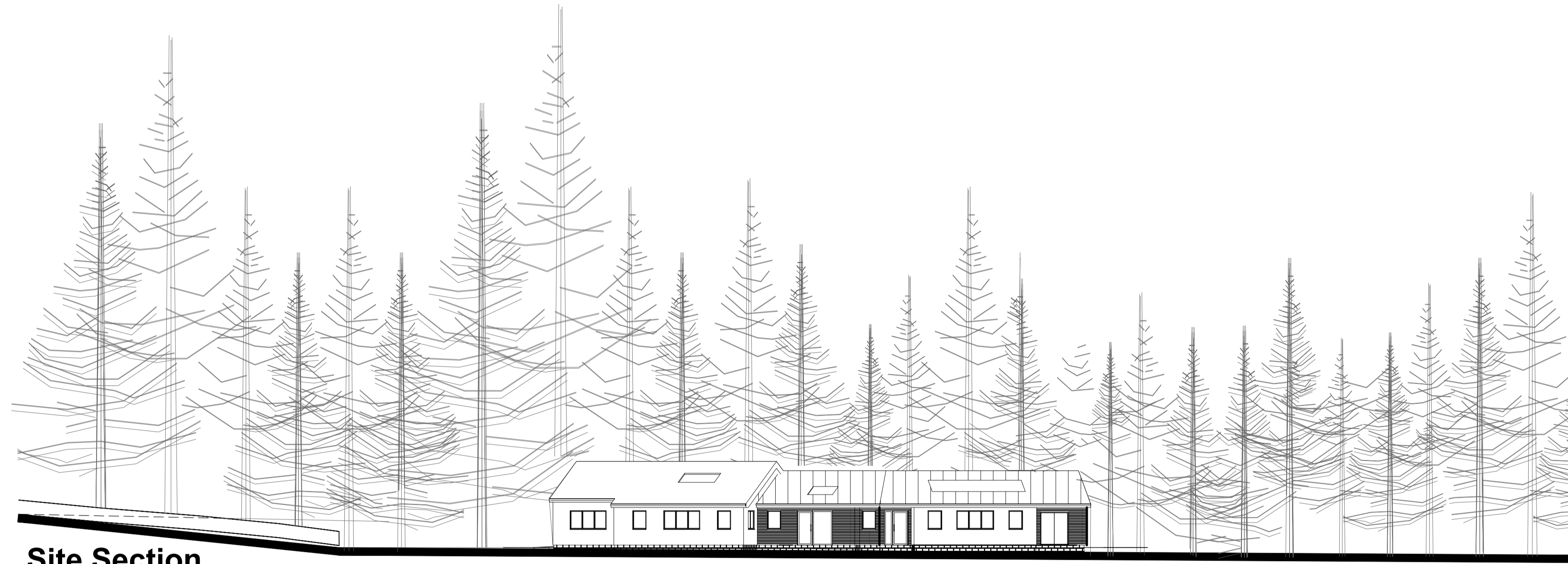


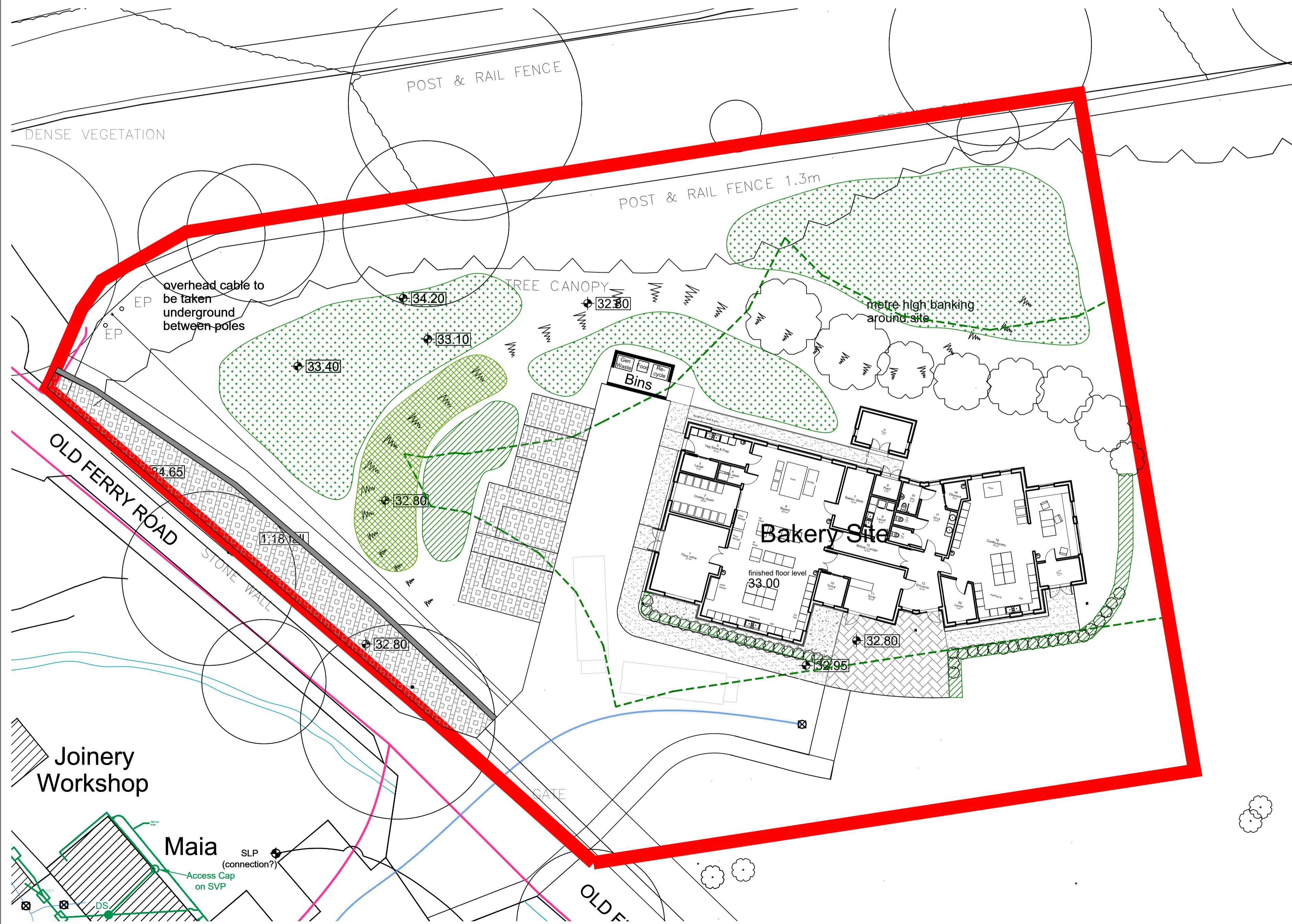
Landscaping Notes

The aim for the proposed development is to encourage bio-diversity through a significant bank of native wildflower planting, along with native trees to screen the Bakery from the raised bank.

The Southern areas of land will also be planted with wildflowers, which will encourage bio-diversity while maintaining a visual link to the Newton Dee Farm activity on the field to the South.
