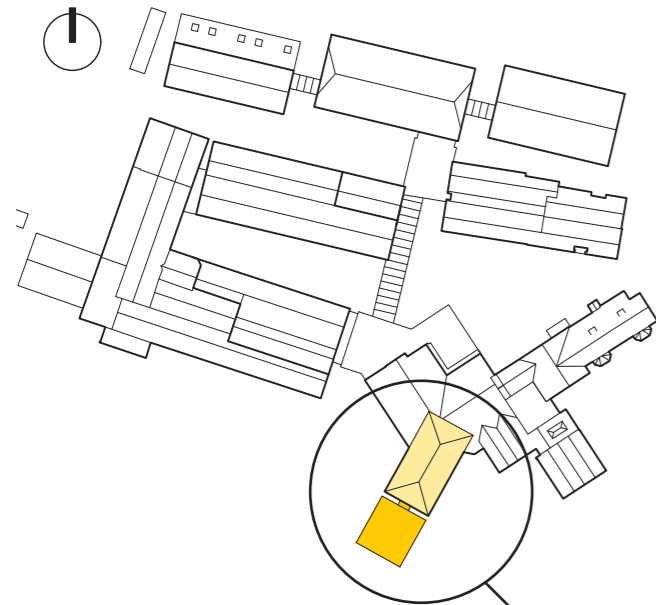




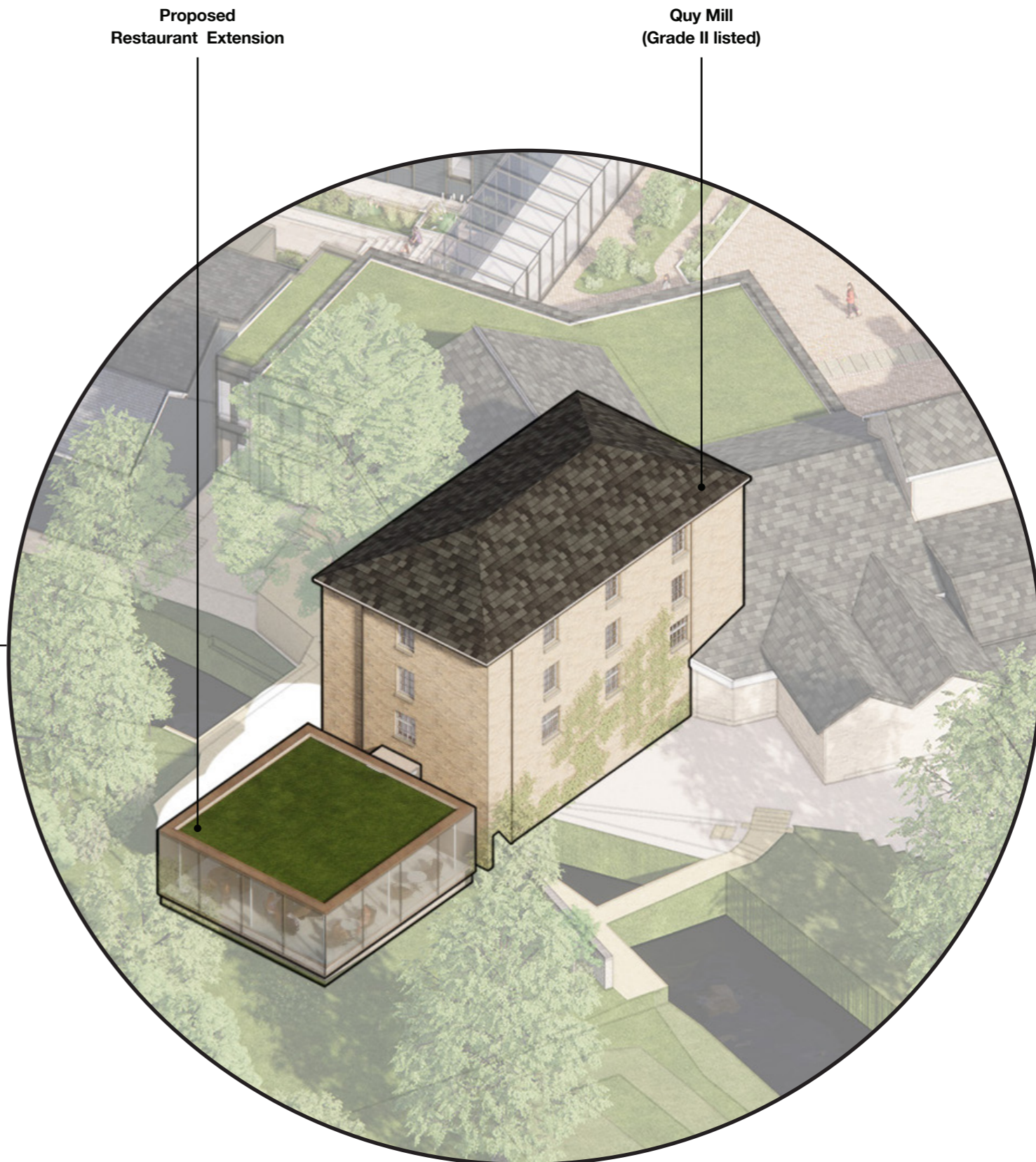
# RESTAURANT EXTENSION

- Quay Mill (Grade II Listed)

The proposed restaurant extension is conceived as a glass box that seamlessly integrates itself within the surrounding vegetation and trees.

This architectural language aims to create a subservient extension to the historic Quay Mill building, ensuring that the new volume does not have a negative impact on the architectural legacy of the context.



# RESTAURANT EXTENSION

The proposed restaurant extension will be accessed through the historic mill area.

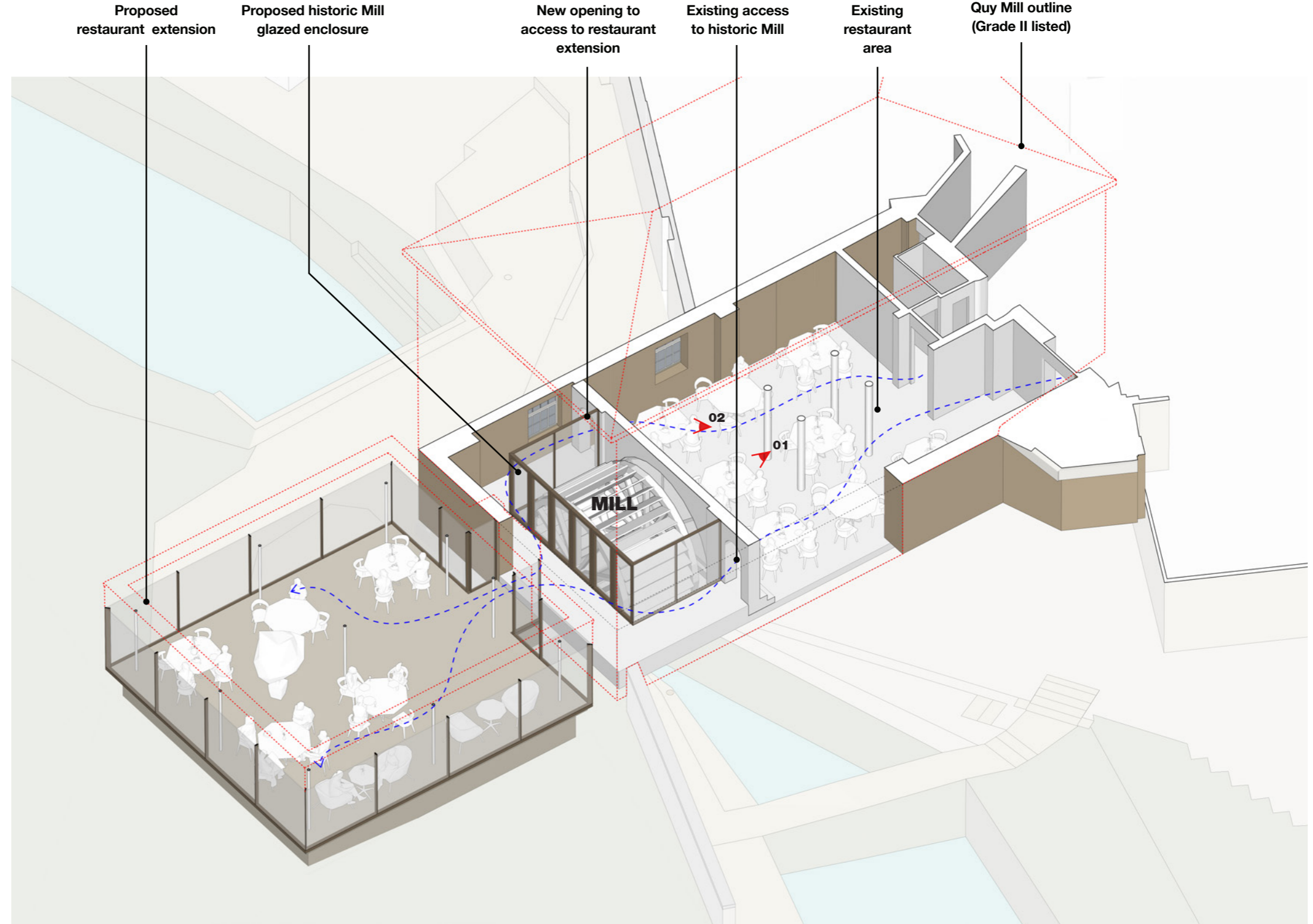
A new opening in the existing wall, separating the current restaurant area, will facilitate two means of access. Additionally, a new glazed enclosure will be proposed to preserve and enhance the current setting of the historic mill.



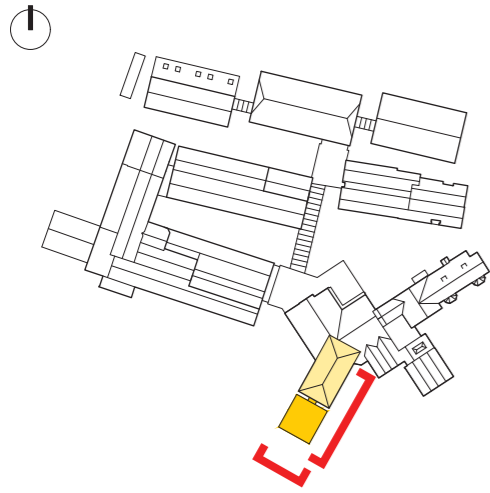
Historic Mill

## PROPOSED MATERIALS

The proposed restaurant extension is designed as a glass box. This material choice will allow the proposed extension to reflect the surrounding vegetation, disappearing and not interfering with the image of the Grade II listed Mill building.

The plinth of the glazed box will be in brick, replicating the materiality of the historic building.

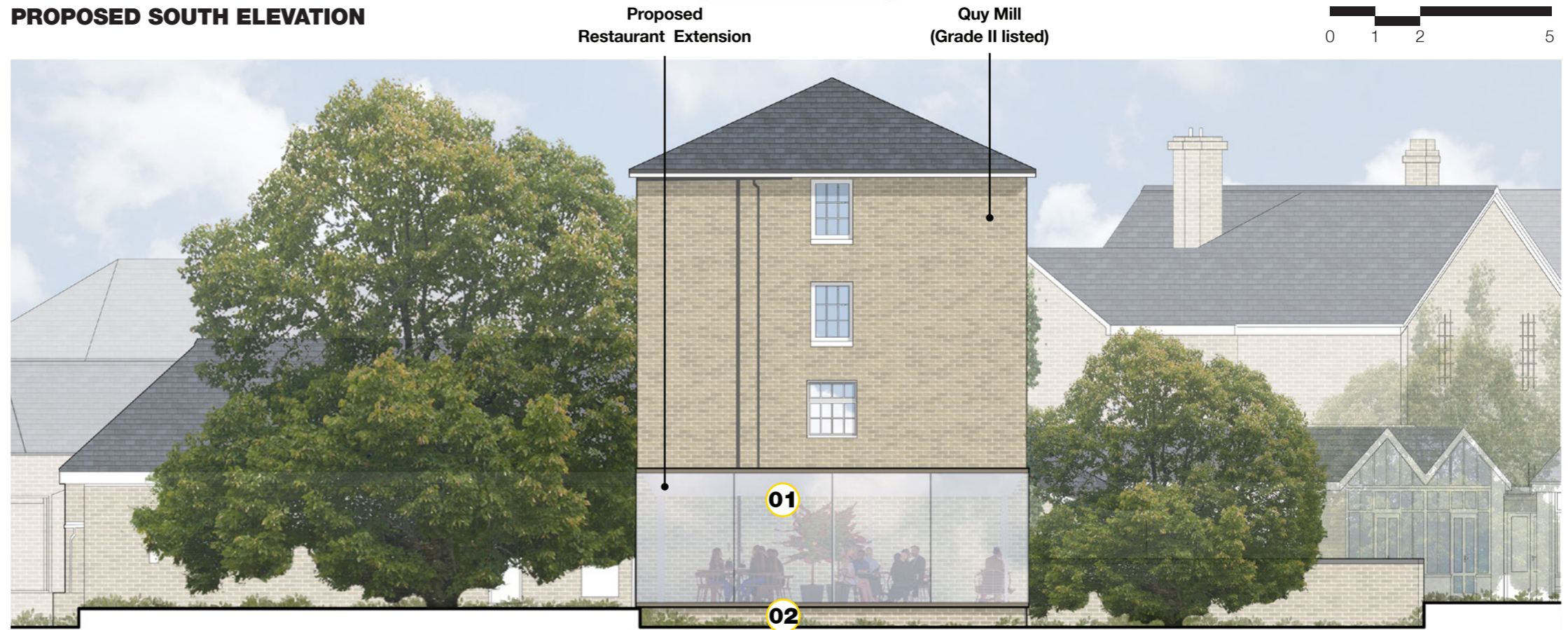

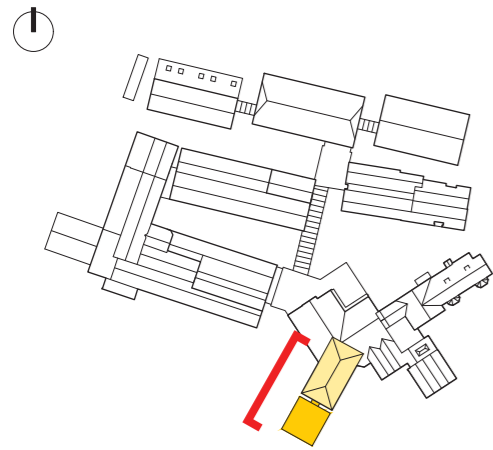
## PROPOSED EAST ELEVATION

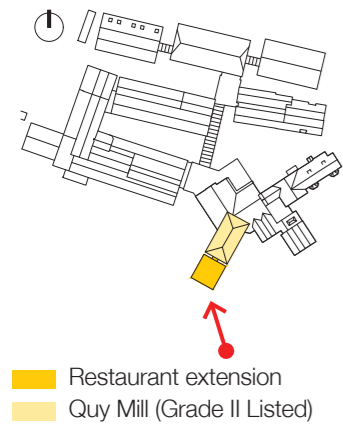
