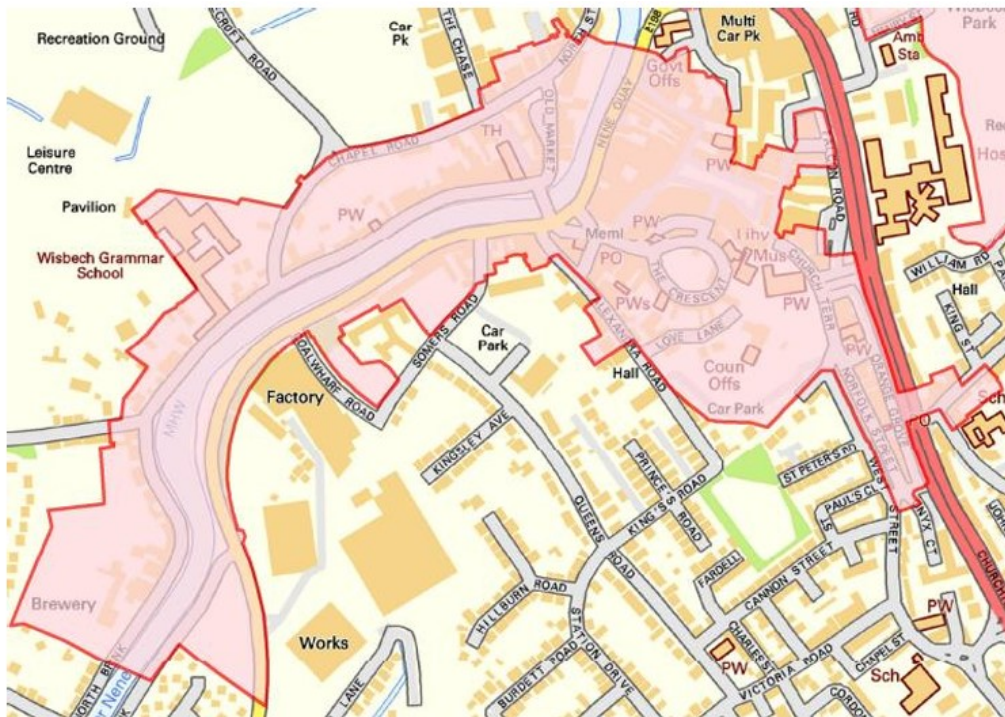

HERITAGE STATEMENT CHANGE OF USE FROM HAIR AND BEAUTY TO RESTAURANT AND TAKEAWAY 106 NORFOLK STREET, WISBECH

The site is within the Wisbech Conservation Area which has a number of listed buildings, No 8 Norfolk Street opposite and the Five Bell's PH being the closest.



8 Norfolk Street, Wisbech, has a Grade 2 listing, with a listing entry 1331627, originally listed 19th November 1976. The building is a small late C17 or early C18 shop. Timber-framed with thatched roof, street facade much altered by large shop window. One storey and attic, side passage to left hand. Thatched dormer window.

The Five Bells Inn dated W.E.R.S. 1745 on stone plaque which may date the re-fronting of an earlier building. Local brown brick, steeply pitched slate roof with stack to right hand. Rendered ground floor. Two storeys. Three first floor hung sash windows, and one blind window with wrought iron inn sign brackets, in gauged red brick arches with stone cills. Three ground floor windows and modern double door to left hand entrance. Has a Grade 2 listing, with a listing entry 1126632, originally listed 19th November 1976.

Consent is sought for the change of use from hair and beauty to restaurant and takeaway, no external or internal alterations are proposed.

The appearance of the building will remain relatively unchanged, with the exception of an extractor fan to the rear elevation.
