PRE-ORDER CONSULTATION – NETTLEWORTH MANOR, WARSOP PARISH, NOTTINGHAMSHIRE NG19 8LJ

The County Council is considering proposals for the extinguishment of two restricted byways and a bridleway in the above-mentioned parish, and concurrent creation of a replacement bridleway as shown on the attached plans.

The restricted byways were originally the subject of a claim to add the route to the Definitive Map made by the Ramblers Association based on historical documentary evidence. The North Northamptonshire County Council (Warsop Restricted Byway Nos.61&62 and Bridleway No.63) Modification Order 2022 to add the restricted byways and a bridleway was made in February 2022, and has not yet been confirmed. The Creation and Extinguishment Orders are contingent on the Modification Order being confirmed.

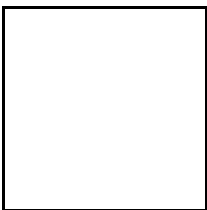
The proposed Restricted Byway Warsop No.61 is in part covered with trees and is missing a crossing of the River Meden. In consequence the County Council have felt it is expedient that an alternative route is put in place and an extinguishment made, should the Definitive Map Modification Order be confirmed.

The replacement bridleway would follow an amended route between B and E on the Creation plan, running along the field edges instead of through Ox Pasture Wood. Warsop Bridleway No.63 duplicates part of Restricted Byway No.62 and would be extinguished at the same time.
