Description of works -


These works have been identified on the Tree Survey carried out by Amenity Tree with the works and TPO application carried out by ATW Tree and Landscaping Specialists LTD.


<u>T4 - Large cavity at base of tree up to approximately 1m in height, tree has lean towards school</u> premises, recommend for removal.












T19 – Common Black Elder - Elder in decline, signs of dead throughout tree, cavity at 1m up stem, saprophytic fungi (Jews Ear) common on Elder but large amount of dead evident throughout crown, bad specimen close to playing field, remove to eliminate risk.








<u>T24 – Common horse chestnut - Horse Chestnut stump at 0.5M, cut down to ground level to remove trip hazard.</u>







<u>T33 – Common Ash - Inonutus hispidus evident on stem @ approximately 1.5m, unclear if Ash has</u> developed die back at this stage due to time of year. Ash is leaning over playground remove to eliminate risk.





<u>T67 – Common Ash - Windblown Ash already processed prior to survey, leave in length for habitat, saprophytic Jews Ear evident, no works required.</u>











<u>T93 – Sycamore - Difficult to determine trees health due to Ivy engulfing stem and crown, remove Ivy to reinspect.</u>



<u>T111 -Swedish Sycamore - Crown has been removed and left as standing stem, no work required.</u>











<u>T136 – Common Lime - Massive lean southward to school building, poor specimen, suggest removal.</u>












<u>T137 - Common Ash - Major deadwood in the majority of crown, overhang on entrance road to Sixth Form, has all the characteristics of dieback, recommend removal or pollard at the very least.</u>











<u>T139 – Common Lime - Large tear/cavity @ 4m on main stem, heartwood visible. Affecting crown of adjacent Yew, Lime is a poor specimen, removal recommended.</u>










<u>T161 – Common Ash - Windblown Ash, tips of crown touching wall, process and leave in piles for habitat.</u>








<u>T167 – Sycamore - Severe westerly lean within falling distance of playground, Sycamore is a poor specimen which may have had scaffold branch failure @ 6m easterly side, hard to determine due to lvy, recommend fell to eliminate risk.</u>








<u>T213 – Black elder - Remove Elder stump to ground level.</u>
