**Notification of intention to carry out works to a tree in a Conservation Area**

<b>Site:</b>	132 Church Road Bradmore Wolverhampton West Midlands WV3 7EJ
<b>Proposal:</b>	T1, T2 & T3 - Holly Trees - Remove new growth from trees, trimming to shape. G1 - Mixed species hedge - Reduce height to around height of fence, removing up to 2m of growth. This is to allow more light into rear gardens and create a more manageable hedgerow.

The City of Wolverhampton as the Local Planning Authority has decided not to make a Tree Preservation Order and hereby advise that you may **proceed** with the above works, subject to gaining any other necessary permissions.
