

Front view

Plaque design

Drawing number: HPT-Detail-1

1:5 at A4

Aluminium baseplate, painted black. Non-ferrous dowels recessed in baseplate and fixed to external wall with masonry adhesive

Aluminium cast plaque painted in black with raised lettering and outer ring edge detailed in white fixed to baseplate with all-weather adhesive

Notes:

Where possible, fixings will be installed in mortar joints.

At some sites rendering obscures location of mortar joints, and installation may be into masonry.
