MILE END

ORIGINALLY DOUNE'S PRINCIPAL COACHING INN, WITH STABLES BEHIND. THE LICENCE FOR SELLING SPIRITS LAPSED ON THE DEATH OF THE OWNER IN 1890 AND IT BECAME A TEMPERANCE INN PROVIDING SHELTER AND NOURISHMENT FOR WEARY TRAVELLERS AND LOCALS. MANY ORIGINAL FEATURES ARE STILL PRESENT INCLUDING THE IRON RING OUTSIDE TO TETHER HORSES. INSIDE, A MILLSTONE AND WELL SURVIVE.
