Current Situation: Mr Wilson resides with his wife and his son in a privately owned, 3 bedroomed bungalow. Currently Mr Wilson has a bathroom with shower, bath tub, standard sink and toilet in situ however this is no longer meeting his current or long term needs due to type of shower tray and shower enclosure. Further Mr Wilson is no longer able to access his home or wider community independently due to external steps at both entrances.

Medical Condition: Mr Wilson suffers from [REDACTED]

Problems Caused: Difficulty with [REDACTED] community.

Alternatives Considered: Alternatives not suitable for condition and its progression. Rehousing not considered at present time.

Proposal: To install a level access shower (LAS) in existing bathroom. To install external ramp for access to home and wider community.

Occupational Therapist's Recommendation: I support Mr Wilson's application for a grant to install a LAS and ramp. This will enable safe and independent access [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] personal care needs. Further a LAS will provide access for his wife or support staff to attend to his personal care needs at later stage if necessary. This LAS will increase service user's safety, energy conservation and improve his quality of life. Further an external ramp will support safe and independent access to and from home as well as access to garden and wider community.
