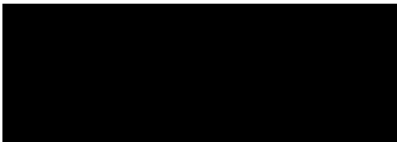
We write to make application for replacement of the wood double hung sash windows to the first and second floor front and part rear elevations, with Heritage style uPVC double hung sash windows of matching design.

An earlier application DM2023/00194 was refused and we now re-submit with an alternative uPVC window that has been specifically designed for use and approval in Conservation areas. Attached is the manufacturer's literature which has several examples of the window style being approved in conservation areas. We are proposing to install Masterframe Bygone Symphony Range windows

We have also recently gained approval for use of the Bygone Symphony Range windows in a similar property in Kingston where following initial refusal to use standard uPVC windows to replace wood sash windows, approval was subsequently granted for use of the Symphony Range windows.
