

St. Peter's Church, 153 High Street, Linlithgow

This proposal is for the installation of a CCTV security system which has been donated to the church. The building is subject to regular attempts to make forced entry and the installation of cameras has become necessary as an additional deterrent.

Four cameras are proposed – one on each of the three rear elevations around the hall and one on the street frontage. They have built in infrared lights and so no separate light fitting will be required.

The first one will look back down towards the bottom of the access pend stairs. The second will cover the rear doors of the hall itself and the third will look down the west elevation towards the memorial garden and the door out to that side.

The fourth one will be located so that it covers the main front door of the church.


They will be positioned so as to not point in the direction of any neighbouring gardens or windows. The recordings will be retained for a maximum of ten hours only.
