MORAY INSTITUTE

FROM 1843 TO 1859 THE
FORMER SITE OF THE
INDEPENDENT CHURCH WAS
USED AS PAROCHIAL OFFICES
AND AS A READING ROOM.
IN 1888 A NEW BUILDING
WAS GIFTED BY THE EARL
OF MORAY AND OPENED AS
THE MORAY INSTITUTE.
IT PROVIDED A LIBRARY,
READING ROOM AND 'FIRST
CLASS' BILLIARD TABLE. THE
FORMER BURGH COUNCIL
MET HERE BETWEEN 1890
AND 1922. SINCE THEN
THE INSTITUTE HAS BEEN
CONVERTED TO HOUSING.
