Transport and Highways Impact and Noise Assessment Statements

Transport and Highways Impact Statement

- Access to Station Farm Camping is from Shapwick Road using an existing stoned driveway. Visibility at entrance/exit is good.
- A maximum of 20 pitches will only ever be available with one vehicle parking space per pitch.
- Campers arriving by bike are encouraged (campsite is on National Cycle Route 3). Bike storage is provided.
- **Conclusion:** Minimal increase in traffic due to campsite.

Noise Assessment Statement

- Station Farm Camping has no near neighbours (closest neighbour is 200 metres from campsite)
- Campsite will be marketed as an off-grid, back to nature, peaceful campsite. Electrical hook ups will not be provided.
- Maximum of 20 pitches provided.
- Karl and Bethan Dyga live on site and will be present whenever campsite is operating. Any campers creating antisocial levels of noise will be asked to reduce noise level. If this does not occur, they will be requested to leave the campsite.
- **Conclusion**: Campsite will result in minimal increase to noise levels.
