NOTES ON PROPOSAL.

The proposal is to erect a memorial cairn in remembrance of members who have sadly died.

Historically, name plaques were added to various benches around the course, however, due to the large numbers, there is no space left on these.


A cairn would provide a suitable place for inscribed metal plaques to be positioned in one central location on the golf course.

It would be of simple construction, blockwork finished with a smooth white coat and a black slate top to which the appropriate metal inscribed name plates would be added. There is no proposal to change the existing ground level(s).

Its location is proposed to the west of an existing access track, within the course, to the south of the ladies and gents' tee at the 13<sup>th</sup> hole.

The photograph below shows the location as marked by the red and white ranging poles.
