


Replacment Window Plan Section

O Locations of brush or compressible draft seals




1. All window joinery timber unless otherwise stated to be joinery quality softwood (HW cill) plained and sanded and externally to receive white gloss paint finish. Finishes to be agreed with Client. Door and frame to be Oak.

2. Weatherseal to be a suitable sized compression seals and brush seals fitted to all joints (see red dots on details or similar as approved). Seals to be installed in rebated joints all to manufacturers details as required.

3. Window junctions with surround are to be sealed with a suitable coloured silicone mastic. DPC to be incorporated between frame and existing brickwork as good practice.4. All windows and doors are to be glazed with safety glass as and where required by

5. Each window is to be fitted with traditional balanced sash cord/weight pulley system. Type of Ironmongery to clients approval but must include lifting handles and opening restrictors.

6. The sizes shown on this drawing are indicative and the joinery details are to be similar to that which they replace. Joiner MUST notify client if there is any concern about integrity/suitability of joinery sizes shown.
