Our applicant is easily a planning permission for argued mounted color pends to be leasted as because of the Address Lang Ash Wasdhridge
Our applicant is seeking planning permission for ground mounted solar panels to be located on her property, Address: Long Ash, Woodbridge Lane, Withington, Cheltenham GL54 4 BP
The proposal is for a line of 20 panels in portrait, one high, at an angle of 30-35 degrees, c.150m from the house, running underneath the
national grid lines from the pylon in the field behind the property.
Panels would be 1.134m by 2.278m (545kW panels) and therefore extend a row 22.68m long, height at 35 degrees 1.3m, plus fixing height off the ground, and front to back c.2.0m so covering an area c.45m2.
The ambition is to site the panels close to (within 1-2m of) the boundary fence/hedge.
