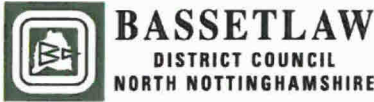

Copper Beeches has an old stables block within the curtilage of the address. The ground floor is used predominantly as a garage. This has over the years been subject to various alterations. The proposal is to renovate the interior stone walls as follows: To effect the removal of Superlux 8 x 4 tiles and wooden lathe, clean stone-work of old peeling paint, rake out joints and repoint with a lime based mortar. Install lead flashing to roof tiles where the roof butts up to the gable end wall of an adjoining property in order to prevent water running down the inside of the building.

This address is joined onto the stables where works are proposed. There is no lead flashing where the roofline of the stables butts up to their gable end wall. When it rains, water is running down the wall iside the stables and also poses a risk of penetrating damp occurring inside the adjoining property.

Request to cut into stone wall on their gable end to insert lead flashing and make good with lime based mortar. No issues and proposal welcomed.
