covering. Excavate around the roots which is lifting the drive. Remove surfacing roots to facilitate re-laying drive surface. There are tree roots lifting the surface which have become a trip hazard. The landscaper has confirmed that the tree roots are lifting the surface., The roots are coming through from the T1:Birch in Front garden No.8. The T2: Lime tree is in the front

garden of No.9. Potential hazard.

I refer to your application of proposed tree works at the above location, received on 7 February 2024. I am writing to inform you that your application is incomplete for the following reason(s):

1 You have not submitted appropriate evidence in support of your statement of reasons for the proposed tree work.

You must provide additional evidence from an arboriculturist and/ or other appropriate expert to support your proposals if your reasons for carrying out tree works are because of the condition of the tree or alleged damage to property.

2 You have not provided a full and clear specification of the works which you propose.

A proposal simply to `Remove surfacing roots' is too vague, because it fails to identify the extent of the works. Instead, you should identify each root that is proposed to be cut.
