I acknowledge receipt of your Prior Notification Application for a change of use in respect of the above which was received as valid on 13 March 2024. I may have changed your description of the proposal to make it more clear, but if you are not satisfied please let me know.

I have until 56 days after the receipt of the application to deal with your application. If Prior Approval is refused you can appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment. You should appeal within 6 months of the date of the decision and you must use a form which you can get from the Planning Inspectorate at Chartroom, The Planning Inspectorate, Eagle Wing, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6PN. This does not apply if your application has already been referred to the Secretary of State for the Environment.
