New cobble setts (2 x strips)

Reclaimed blue terracotta edging (to new pathway to north of pool only)

Stone retaining wall structure to north of pool

New pathways (bitumen with PCC pin kerb, unless stated as otherwise below)

- New section of pathway to north of reinstated pool (with reclaimed terracotta edging)
- New section of pathway leading to car park
- New ramped pathway leading to Sons of Rest Pavilion terrace

Pathway Resurfacing (bitumen overlay, reset existing kerb)

- Resurface small section of pathway linking Senses Garden to pool
- Resurface pathways to leading up to Sons of Rest Pavilion
- Resurface small section of pathway to south side of reinstated pool
- Resurface full length of pathway to east of reinstated pool Resurface small section of pathway (approx. 10m long)
- Resurfacing to Stourport Road / Park Lane entrance













