



Dust Management Statement

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Site Name: Yara UK Ltd, Chedburgh

Contractor Name: Delta Engineering Group Ltd

It shall be the responsibility of the site manager to monitor and control the emission of dust during the site construction phase. The technically competent site manager shall appoint a suitably trained deputy to oversee the management of dust during times that the site manager is not on site.

The following operations have the potential to produce dust:

- Breaking the old building floor slab
- Excavating new floor foundations
- Loading/unloading transport with the spoils
- Transporting spoil across site.

There will be a range of mitigations put in place to ensure that the development on site does not have an adverse impact due to the production of dust on the surrounding population, flora and fauna. These measures will include:

- Daily visual inspections will be carried out by the site manager, or his deputy, of the whole site. There will be particular focus during dry, windy weather to ensure any potential sources of dust are identified and treated promptly with the application of water.
- If any operations are identified as causing visible dust emissions to carry across the site boundary, they shall be suspended until effective remedial action can be taken or conditions change.
- Water to be used to damp down any areas being observed generating dust.
- High standards of housekeeping to be maintained at all times
- Loading and tipping heights shall be minimised where possible
- Site speed limits to be observed at all times
- Should visible dust be blown from spoil heaps they shall be treated with water
