

Soils Management Plan

Burdocks, Fittleworth Road, Wisborough Green RH14 0HA

In support of planning application PP-12646891 for creation of a tennis court

The landscaping of the area within the curtilage of the private garden will be conducted within the National Park guidelines i.e. re soil management, materials etc.

The land is deemed to be garden land with no known or anticipated contamination risk.

The tennis court will be constructed in a 2-tone green finish to blend better with the surrounding area. There will be green mesh fencing surround.

In line with the scaled cross section drawing of the tennis court, all soils/earthworks will be re-used on the project. The tennis court is being created on an incline. The area will be levelled off by moving the soil removed from one end to level up the other end with a new green sleeper wall supporting the changes.

Any soil not utilised in the levelling up will be stored temporarily in an adjacent field as marked on the scale plan and will be re-instated as part of the landscaping within the curtilage and will support the introduction of additional box hedging as mentioned in the landscape appraisal.

There will be no impact on the surrounding neighbours, and all works will be set within the curtilage of the existing garden like the precedent already set by the tennis court in Brick Kiln Common.
