

The Planning (Hazardous Substances) Act 1990

The Planning (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2015 (Regulation 6) – Notices of Application for Hazardous Substances Consent

I give notice that Indian Queens Power Ltd is applying to Cornwall Council for a Hazardous Substances Consent, relating to the storage of fuel at Indian Queens Power Station, Gaverigan, St Dennis, St Austell, PL26 8BY. Cornwall Council will decide whether or not to grant consent. If necessary, they will also decide on what conditions to grant consent, with advice given by the COMAH (Control of Major Accident Hazards) competent authority.
