**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 - SECTION 119  
CORNWALL COUNCIL**

**The Cornwall Council (Footpath Nos. 37, 42, 43 & 71 (Parts) Newquay)  
(Land at Trevelgue Head and Watergate) Public Path Diversion Order 2024**

The above order made on 6 February 2024, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert a length of Public Footpath number 42 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 116 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 8299/6295, then continuing in a south-south-westerly then west-south-westerly direction for a distance of 56 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 169 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8294/6292, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 116 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 8299/6295, then continuing in a west-south-westerly direction for a distance of 52 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 169 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8294/6292, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 42 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 273 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8282/6294, then continuing in a westerly, then west-north-westerly then north-north-westerly then north-westerly direction for a distance of 105 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 357 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8273/6299, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 273 metres west-south-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8282/6294, then continuing in a west-north-westerly, then north-westerly then westerly direction for a distance of 85 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by another Order at OSGR SW 8275/6299, then running in a westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 357 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8273/6299, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 42 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 373 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8271/6299, then continuing in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 386 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8270/6300, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 373 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8271/6299, then continuing in a northerly then north-westerly direction for a distance of 8 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by this Order at OSGR SW 8271/6300, then continuing in a westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 386 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8270/6300, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 43 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 42 Newquay to be retained, 386 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8270/6300, then continuing in a north-north-easterly then east-north-easterly then north-north-easterly then north-north-westerly then easterly direction for a distance of 205 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 277 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8282/6309, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by this Order,

378 metres west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8271/6300, then continuing in a north-easterly then east-north-easterly direction for a distance of 47 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by another Order at OSGR SW 8274/6302, then continuing in a east-north-easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by another Order at OSGR SW 8276/6303, then continuing in a north-north-easterly then easterly direction for a distance of 96 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 277 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8282/6309, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 43 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 265 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8283/6309, then continuing in a east-north-easterly then east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 102 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 165 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8293/6305, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 265 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8283/6309, then continuing in a east-south-easterly then south-easterly direction for a distance of 34 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by another Order at OSGR SW 8286/6307, then continuing in a east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 70 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, approximately 165 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8293/6305, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 43 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 Newquay to be retained, 139 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8296/6306, then continuing in a north-north-easterly then east-north-easterly then east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 161 metres terminating at its junction with Classified Road B3276, 63 metres north of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8309/6307, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 43 to be retained, 139 metres west-north-west of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8296/6306, then continuing in a north-north-easterly then easterly then south-easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres terminating at its junction with Classified Road B3276, 64 metres north of "Porth Beach Hotel" at OSGR SW 8309/6307, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 37 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with Classified Road B3276, 29 metres west of "1 Trevelgue Road" at OSGR SW 8312/6311, then running in a generally northerly direction for a distance of 172 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 173 metres north-north-west of "1 Trevelgue Road" at OSGR SW 8310/6328, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with Classified Road B3276, 37 metres north-north-west of "1 Trevelgue Road" at OSGR SW 8313/6314, then running in a north-westerly then north-north-easterly then northerly direction for a distance of 42 metres to its junction with a Public Footpath to be created by another Order at OSGR SW 8312/6317, then continuing in a north-north-westerly then northerly direction for a distance of 110 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 173 metres north-north-west of "1 Trevelgue Road" at OSGR SW 8310/6328, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 37 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 82 metres west of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8322/6337, then continuing in a east-north-easterly then north-north-easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 147 metres north-north-west of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8326/6351, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 82 metres west of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8322/6337, then continuing in a east-north-easterly then northerly direction for a distance of approximately 164 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 147 metres north-north-west of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8326/6351, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 37 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 71 Newquay to be retained, 184 metres north-north-west of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8327/6355, then continuing in a generally north-north-easterly direction for a distance of 111 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 71 to be extinguished by this order, at OSGR SW 8333/6364, then continuing in a northerly then north-easterly direction for a distance of 110 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 376 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8336/6374, and to divert a length of Public Footpath number 71 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 71 Newquay to be retained, 246 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8333/6361, then continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 28 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be extinguished by this Order, 272 metres north of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8333/6364, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 71 Newquay to be retained, 246 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8333/6361, then continuing in a north-north-easterly then northerly then north-easterly then northerly direction for a distance of 136 metres to its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 376 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8336/6374, and;

Divert a length of Public Footpath number 37 in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 to be retained, 387 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8337/6375, then continuing in a east-north-easterly then north-north-easterly then northerly direction for a distance of 600 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, 626 metres west-north-west of "Trevelsue Bungalow" at OSGR SW 8373/6419, to a line of Public Footpath in the Parish of Newquay commencing at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, approximately 387 metres north-north-east of "Sands Family Resort" at OSGR SW 8337/6375, then continuing in a south-easterly then north-north-easterly then north-easterly then north-north-easterly then easterly then northerly then north-north-easterly then north-north-westerly direction for a distance of 662 metres to its junction with another part of Public Footpath 37 Newquay to be retained, approximately 626 metres west-north-west of "Trevelsue Bungalow" at OSGR SW 8373/6419.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.

I give notice that Indian Queens Power Ltd is applying to Cornwall Council for a Hazardous Substances Consent, relating to the storage of fuel at Indian Queens Power Station, Gaverfagan, St Dennis, St Austell, PL26 8BY.
