the matters reserved by this permission for further approval by the Local Planning Authority, or, in the case of approval on different dates, the final approval of the last such matter to be approved.

3. The occupation of the dwelling shall be limited to a person employed, or last employed, locally in agriculture, as defined in Section 221(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or in forestry, or a dependent of such a person residing with him (but including a widow or widower of such a person).
