Location: Rear garden. Tree is located in the middle of flowerbed, and centrally in the garden as the focal feature. It is the tallest tree in the rear garden.

I am a resident of the conservation area and I am writing to seek your approval for some works on the Conifer tree in my rear garden. I respect the council's policy of protecting the trees in this area, and I am committed to preserving the natural beauty of my garden. I have been looking after the trees and plants in my garden for more than two decades.

However, I have some concerns about the condition and safety of the Conifer tree, which is very old and has a sparse crown relative to its height. Several branches have broken off over the years due to the harsh weather and strong winds. I fear that more branches may fall and pose a risk to people or property nearby. The tree also sways significantly during windy weather, especially when the wind speed is high. I do not intend to remove the tree, as it is a beloved and attractive feature of my rear garden. Rather, I would like to request your permission to engage a certified tree surgeon to reduce the crown by 30% and trim the shape of the tree all round as it has many overgrown branches that make it look messy and uneven. This will help the tree to grow healthier and stronger, and make it easier for me to care for it. I want to ensure that this tree has every opportunity to survive and flourish, as it has been here for a long time and it is very precious to me.

Therefore, I kindly ask that you review my proposal and grant me permission to carry out the works on the Conifer tree. Thank you for your consideration and cooperation. Please find attached photos of the Conifer tree as part of my application to assist you in your decision.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.
