Good morning.

I wish to object to this application, initially, on the basis of there not (yet) being enough information on the Planning Portal to justify felling this tree.

The only available documentation that is not a photograph is the generic application form. The only thing to go off in here is where the applicant has ticked "yes" to the question on whether the tree is either diseased or there are fears that it might break or fall. There is nothing else to elaborate on this. Until there is, it should be rejected outright.

If/when further information is provided I would urge the LPA to work with the applicant consider whether less drastic measures - which keep the tree alive but remove/reduce risk - would be feasible and preferable.
