

The Old Church, Mockbeggar Lane, Ibsley

CCTV Installation

DESIGN & ACCESS STATEMENT

- The Church was broken into in early 2024. They entered by smashing one of the original lead lined windows, peeling back the lead and climbing in. The police have stated that the building is an easy target.
- The CCTV proposed is minimal, with only one mini dome camera installed to the front and rear. Both mid-way on the elevation to try and capture as much of the approach routes as possible.
- The east and west elevations are exposed, but we are conscious that too many cameras will likely not be accepted. Hence the proposal for only two.
- Ideally the camera can act as a deterrent to theft and vandals. Ideally a larger camera is more of a deterrent, but a small mini camera has been selected to have the least impact on the elevations of the building.
- Camera surface fixed to the timber fascia/soffit.
