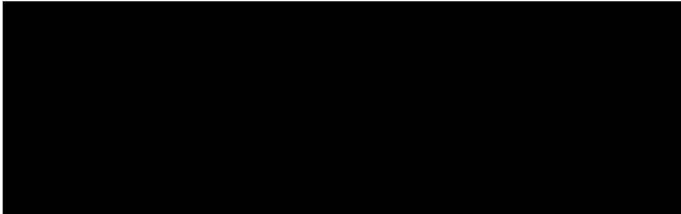
DISPLAY OF SITE NOTICE

Please find enclosed a site notice(s), which provides notification to the public, that an application has been received by the Planning Department at Winchester City Council. The local planning authority is required by law to give adequate publicity to this application. Please display this notice(s) in a prominent position outside the land or property/properties to which the application relates, within 5 working days of receipt of this letter.

To ensure that the application is processed as quickly and efficiently as possible, please make sure that you do the following:

- **Make sure you display the notice(s) promptly between the dates shown on the notice (for 21 days in total)**
- **Make sure you remove the site notice at the end of the 21 day period**
- **Display the notice(s) on the land on the highway frontage or appropriate boundary where it is most visible to the public e.g. gateway, lamp post, telegraph pole.**
- **Display the notice so it can be easily read by pedestrians**
- **Don't attach one to a road sign as this could distract motorists from the main purpose of the sign**
- **Complete and return the tear off slip**

Checks will be carried out, so please try to ensure that you have displayed the site notice(s) in a sensible position and for the correct length of time.
