



Following the Tree Survey carried out by AV Arboriculture on 19th & 25th of December 2023, in accordance with BS 5837:2012, Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction, the following classifications have been recorded.

- Trees classified as Category A
- Trees classified as Category B
- Trees classified as Category C
- Trees classified as Category U
- Recommended Root Protection Area (RPA) Equal to an area 12 times that of the stem diameter

From BS5837:2012, RPA: 'Impact design tool indicating the minimum area around a tree deemed to contain sufficient roots and rooting volume to maintain the tree's stability, and where the protection of the roots and soil structure is treated as a priority.'
