Water Neutrality

Following submission of the Neutrality Statement the proposal will cause an increase in water consumption of 47 l/day. To reduce the increased water consumption level as stated in the report it is proposed that the following will be incorporated into the proposal;

Rain water harvesting and storage tank (51.6 l/day reduction) TOTAL REDUCTION OF 51.6 l/day

We are satisfied that the overall water demand will be reduced and the site will become water neutral. A condition should be used to ensure this takes place and also ensure the fittings retained within the property or only replaced with fittings with the same efficiency or a higher level of efficiency.

Bats

Due to the presence of bats in the local area and the sites location within the buffer zone for Singleton and Cocking Tunnel SAC bats we require that there is no external lighting at part of the scheme.

We require that a bat box is installed on the buildings onsite facing south/south westerly positioned 3-5m above ground.

Hedgehogs

Any brush pile, compost and debris piles on site could provide shelter areas and hibernation potential for hedgehogs. If any piles need to be removed outside of the hibernation period mid-October to mid-March inclusive. The piles must undergo soft demolition. A hedgehog nesting box should be installed within the site to provide future nesting areas for hedgehogs

Nesting Birds

Any works to the trees or vegetation clearance on the site should only be undertaken outside of the bird breeding season which takes place between 1st March 1st October. If works are required within this time an ecologist will need to check the site before any works take place (within 24 hours of any work).

We would like a bird box to be installed on the building / and or tree within the site.

Trees

Due to the removal of a number of trees on the site we require that these are replaced elsewhere on the site.
