Reasons for work Statement

Group 1 – Ash – these trees have been previously pollarded and now require the crowns to be maintained at a suitable size to prevent breakage of limbs overhanging grave stones

Group 2 - To repollard the row of Lime trees to maintain pollarding schedule as with any pollarded tree

Group 3 – To reduce the Leylandii to maintain a suitable height for the location and reduce excessive shading of the Church and Vine Cottage

T1 – to reduce the crown size to prevent breakage of limbs under the burden of fruit and to maintain the tree in accordance with previous pruning practices
