Description Of Proposed Development : T1 - Yew tree - lift lower canopy to 3.5m above ground level & reduce whole canopy by 10%, as shown on marked photo attached Work needed to tidy and shape tree growth

Location: Yew Trees Paxford Chipping Campden Gloucestershire

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 8 April 2024 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.

The development falls under Schedule 2 of the above regulations and is within a "sensitive area" because it falls within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty as defined in Regulation 2, subparagraph (1) Interpretation.
